International MTB Bundesliga 2024, Junior Men and Junior Women

1. International MTB Bundesliga Cross-Country („Int. MTB Bundesliga“)

The Int. MTB Bundesliga is an international race series with an overall individual classification for Men Elite and Women Elite as well as Men U23 and Women U23. For the participation and execution of the international races within this race series, the UCI regulations and this general announcement are valid.

All athletes who belong to the Junior class (age group 2006 and 2007) and have a valid UCI license are eligible to start.

3.2 Overall ranking

The points (see point scheme) from the individual XCO races will be added to the overall ranking. There is one strike result. The XCO race in Heubach will be scored with 150% of the points, according to the own point scheme. In the event of a tie, the better placing in the last race in the series will decide.

Participation in the overall winner's ceremony is a prerequisite to claiming the overall prize money. Exceptions may be approved by the coordinator MTB or representative upon request, which must be received by the day before.

4. Registration

Entries for the individual events are made directly to the organizers. Details and the entry deadline can be found in the respective announcements. Late entries can be made on-site for a late entry fee.

5. Starting order

The starting order will be set according to the following rules (Heubach counts Junior Series regulations):

- according to the current UCI rankingnach
- according to the current ranking of the Bundesliga overall ranking (in Saalhausen and Winterberg alternating with the ranking of the 3 Nations Cup)
- then by lots

Sponsored by:

In the first race, the starting order is

- according to the current UCI ranking
- alternating U19 DM 2023 with the U17 DM 2023
- then by lots

6. Application of the 80% regulation

The decision on whether to apply the 80% rule will be made by the President of the Commissaires Panel and the Technical Delegate depending on the course/course characteristics and the number of starters.

7. Start time

The exact schedule can be found in the respective individual announcements and the Technical Guide.
